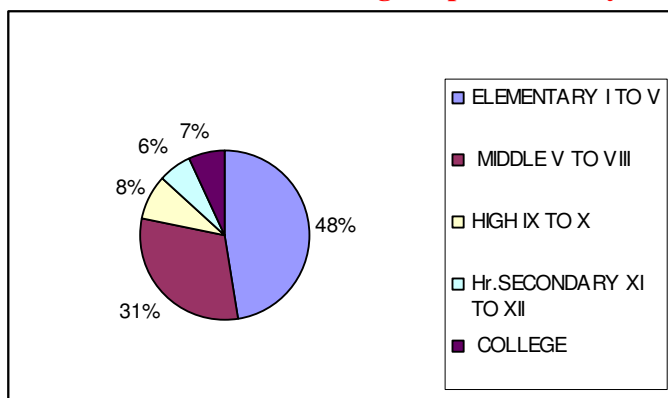

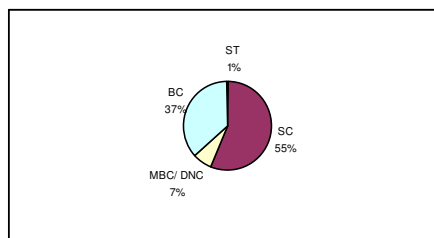

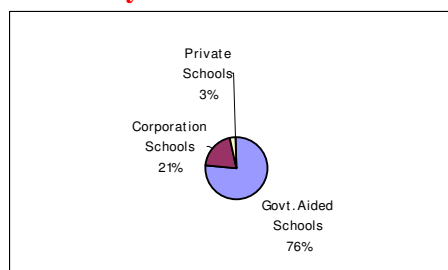

Specifics of Schools where MADURAI SEED children study

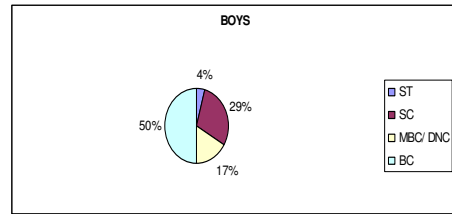

Achievements:

- In this academic year MADURAI SEED has given help for 14 students for higher secondary admission. They have taken groups such as Bio math- (1)Pure Science – (1)Accountancy –(4)Commerce –(9)Engineering –(1) other disciplines-(2)
- In 12th std, the progress is about 86%. 13 students got educational assistance and other helps from MADURAI SEED. M.Thangalakshmi got the 1st mark of 1036 out of 1200. For the last 10 years, among all SEED girl children, she is the first to get this mark. The boy who got 1035 out of 1200 and first boy to score this marks even in biomath group is Saravana Kumar. There is no doubt that these both achievements will make the upcoming students to score more than these.
- Out of 15 in the 12th std, 5 got 75% of marks. 9 students are first graduate from their family.
- In 10th std, the progress is 80%. First mark in 10th std is 475 out of 500. It is the highest mark in the history of Karumbalai for the past 17 years. She is P.Maheshwari from Kakkai Padinear Corporation School. We are very proud of this girl. (A Female SEED volunteer got this marks before 6 years). Among 12 of 10th std 11 are first in their family finished up to 10th std. Maheshwari scored 99 marks in Science. She attended a special class conducted by a resource person on How to score centum in Science.
- Among these 11, Majority is girls. And they all are slow learners. It is a notable thing that these girls passed 10th std by a special teaching given by MADURAI SEED.

VISITORS TO MADURAI SEED

As our visitors, resource persons, researchers as well as guests, MADURAI SEED was visited by 47 friends belonged to various districts, states of India and 49 international friends belonged to USA, Canada, and Switzerland.

All of them cordially have visited and given their lovely presence in MADURAI SEED .It should be noted here that last year, Wisconsin University Professor and scholar Dr. Joseph Elder and renowned Tamil Scholar Dr. Annamalai have visited MADURAI SEED.

In the Beginning of Twelfth Year 2010- 2011:

Too sunny. If the clock strikes 6'o' clock in the evening, we can feel the explosion and severity of the hot on the floor. Besides these, all our three open space centers never meet the lacking of children. They are all over filled with curious kids. Especially, the routine lovely presence of children between 1st std to 8th std is mostly appreciable.

- In the previous academic year, 2009-10, children ranging from 6th std to 9th std., have shown 90% progress. 10th, 11th, and 12th std. Children hopefully get 100% progress. Most of our students are academically little poor. But, they are fully fond of hard work and curiosity to learn.
- The first mark scored in 12th std among our MADURAI SEED children is 938 out of 1200, that is secured by Musthafa Kamal Khan and the second mark is 908 out of 1200 by Nagalakshmi. The other 12th std children get percentages ranging from 50 to 60. All the thirteen children have passed their higher-secondary education.
- All the 16 students of 10th std , Who are equipped by MADURAI SEED Education Centers, have passed their high school education. Manikaraj secured the first mark, 468 out of 500. It is appreciable that he has studied through English medium. Another appreciable thing is about Ramki, getting 404 out of 500, whose pathetic condition of lost his father only two weeks before his examination.
- MADURAI SEED has been conducting a congratulating program for the students scored high marks. Likewise, MADURAI SEED conducted the program at Gandhi Museum. One of our Trustees, V. Mariammal distributed the prizes to M.Muthu Pandi, who got 1130 marks out of 1200, the first generation to step into the college and got an engineering merit admission in Anna Univerity and K.Sathish Kumar who secured 479 marks out 500. He is also the first generation student to go to higher secondary studies. He is the first one, got this level of mark in Karumbalai.
- Out of 13 higher-secondary students of the previous year, two of them committed themselves to work as teaching volunteers and they are provided with scholarships for their college studies. They are Nagalakshmi and Muthumari. It is notable that both are belonged to Dalit community and they are the first generation students to study in college.
- We have 10 eleventh standard students and MADURAI SEED helped them to get admission in various schools and groups. They are belonged to the following groups Bio-Maths, Pure Science, Computer Science, Accounts, Business Maths, Commerce, and Engineering. Most of them are first generation people to get higher secondary studies.
- We have 11 children of twelfth grade. And those all are girls.
- In this year, three of the college students have completed their studies. They are vijay, Sulthan and Periya Samy. 2 of them got their job placement. 5 college students finished their under-graduation. Three of them are doing teacher training course and 2 are studying post graduation in sociology.
